Gators Nook Development

You may have noticed construction outside of the Hall in September. This was Phase 1 of Gators Nook, a beautification project to enhance the area on the west side of the hall to create a space where people can gather and enjoy being outside.

Phase 1 of the project involved clearing and grading the area, replacing retaining walls along the east side of the rink and replacing the south parking lot walkway. This was completed through grants from the City of Calgary and the Province of Alberta.

Phase 2 will take place in Spring and Summer 2026, and will include outdoor seating, planters, and a native plant garden.
